

# **OPAL Term 6 Assembly**

## Responsibility

- **Everyone** needs to help tidy up at the end of play times. If you are near any equipment when the tidy-up whistle goes, pick it up and put it away.
- Opal Squad remember to wear your yellow bibs on your duty day. Please keep making sure equipment is being used properly and also being put away neatly.
- Each class can send out 4 extra volunteers on their Squad day to help get equipment out.

### Water play

- No pipes/tubes in your mouth
- To reduce our water usage, soon we will be getting a water butt that will be filled up and you will take water from this for your water play – once this water is all gone, that's it!
- When we get the water butt, you will no longer use the outdoor tap





#### Cable reels

 If you are rolling along or standing on top of the big cable reel, you must be on the grass and not the playground



#### Chalk and pens

These must stay on the playgrounds

 All chalk and pens need to be returned to the trays/containers at the end of playtimes



#### **Tyres**

 Do not roll tyres over the track – instead, use the grass area to the end of the red playground and roll the tyres down here where there are no obstacles



- You must pay attention to where you are rolling the tyres and check if anyone is in the way
- The tyres are no longer going to be stored next to the water play, but instead at various points around the field

#### Scooters, skateboards and bikes

 You must only use these on the track or field, not on the playground

 The track and grass break your fall and this is important as you are not wearing a helmet





#### Wooden storage boxes

- There are 2 new wooden storage boxes on the KS1 playground and the red playground
- You must **not** take the lid off these yourself as the wood is quite rough and sharp – the Play Team will take the lids off for you

### **Tarpaulins**

 The tarpaulins and plastic sheets can be used to make dens

 You must put them away in the big wooden storage box on the KS1 playground

They are not to be used as water slides
