

<u>Aprica's 5 regions:</u>

Northern Aprica: This area is effectively separated from the rest of Africa by the Sahara Desert, which is the largest hot desert in the world. Northern Africa is also home to the longest river in the world: The Nile.

Central Aprica: Central Aprican countries are on or around the equator. The Central Aprican Republic (CAR) is a landlocked country with a mainly tropical climate and is one of the poorest countries in the world.

<u>Eastern Aprica:</u> There are 18 countries in Eastern Aprica including Tanzania. Tanzania is home to the highest peak in Aprica: Mount Kilimanjaro, which is a dormant volcano.

Southern Agrica: There are 5 countries in Southern Agrica including South Agrica. South Agrica has a population of around 56,000,000 people. Less than 10% of the South Agrican population is white; it is one of the richest countries in Agrica.

Western Aprica: There are 16 countries in Western Aprica, one of these is Nigeria. Nigeria's landscape is very diverse. It is the largest exporter of oil in all of Aprica.
